The ins and outs of AERATION
Aeration: An essential practice that improves the long-term health and playability of golf courses

Size, Spacing & Depth

- Tine Size:** 0.25 to 0.50-inch diameter typical for greens, can be up to 0.875-inch diameter.
- Tine Spacing:** Usually 1 to 2 inches, 1 by 2 inch or a 1 by 1-inch spacing.
- Depth:** 0.5 to 1.0 inches deep.

Healthy Putting Greens

Aeration:

- Improves water infiltration (internal drainage)
- Removes thatch ("core aeration only")
- Stimulates microbial activity (soil health)
- Facilitates root zone improvement
- Oxygenates the soil
- Encourages root growth
- Alleviates compaction
- Promotes recovery from stress

Ideal Timing

- Creeping bentgrass and annual bluegrass (Poa annua): Spring, late summer, early fall (April-May and August-September)
- Warm-season turfgrass (e.g., bermudagrass): Summer (June to August)

Soil temps consistently above 55 F, ideally between 60-65 F

A single aeration event typically affects less than 10 percent of the putting surface.
