My first golf swing coach was Chris Nelson, PGA member and watching how much he loved the game really influenced my wanting to play the game as often as I could find time. As a result, I applied to the PGA Professional Golf Management University Program at Campbell University, Buies Creek, North Carolina for a major in Business Administration. I achieved my degree on time but because of a double major in the PGA PGM golf program, I was also able to receive my study and credits towards my PGA Class 'A' membership which I achieved in 2022. The PGA sanctioned Campbell University golf management program allowed me to compete within the program and participate in the CUPGM tournament series where I earned multiple wins and achieved more than 10 Top 5 finishes. Just as important as playing experience was the ability to learn from more

experienced teachers like David Orr (Golf Magazine Top 100) and Jorge Parada, lead instructor at Liberty National Golf Club and Campbell PGA PGM program graduate.

Throughout my time as golfer, student and professional, I have observed, taken, and given hundreds of lessons. I have learned and continue to learn from these experiences and from these great coaches. Through that period, I have formulated my own teaching philosophy centered around the fundamentals of the game and a methodology that focuses not on teaching my students the game but coaching my students on how they can play their best golf.
